
#### Nova Scotia's Historic Acadian Village

Located on a beautiful 17 acre site that provides a breathtaking view of the Pubnico Harbour, the historic Acadian Village of Nova Scotia invites you to step back in time to discover the heart, life, and culture of the Acadians in the early 1900s. It is an ideal setting to learn more about the greatest source of pride of the Acadian people – the deportation of 1755 and their continuing prosperity.



#### Musée des Acadiens des Pubnicos

When visiting the Musée des Acadiens, you will be taking a time machine back to 1653 to meet with its founders and appreciate the resourcefulness of its residents. It also houses a research centre, Les Archives Père Clarence d'Entremont, which has more than 6,000 original publications on various supports. The program also includes a guided tour of a traditional Acadian garden.




#### Tusket Island Tours
