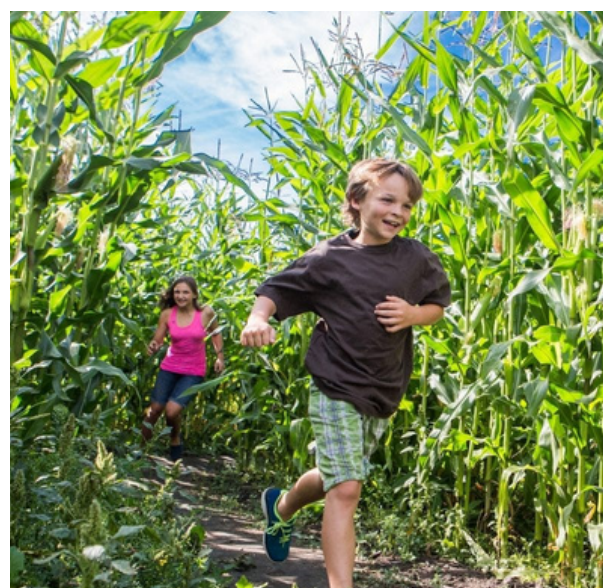


### St. Paul
