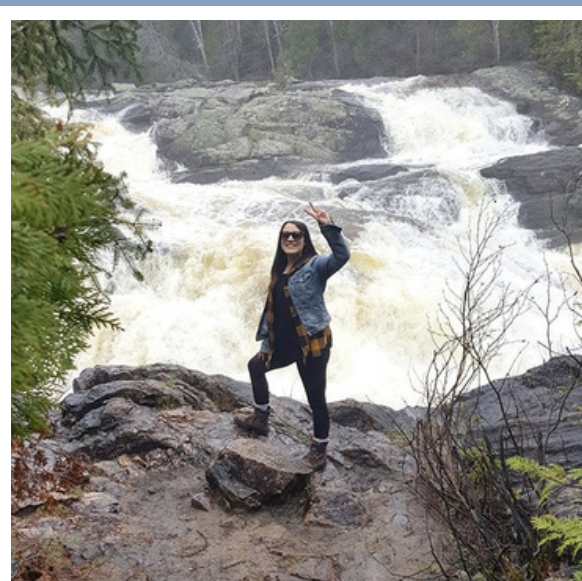

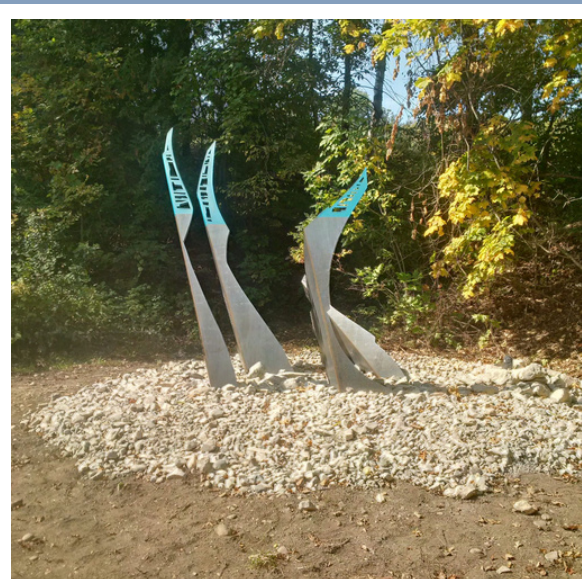


### [Blag Bear Eco Adventure Routes](#)

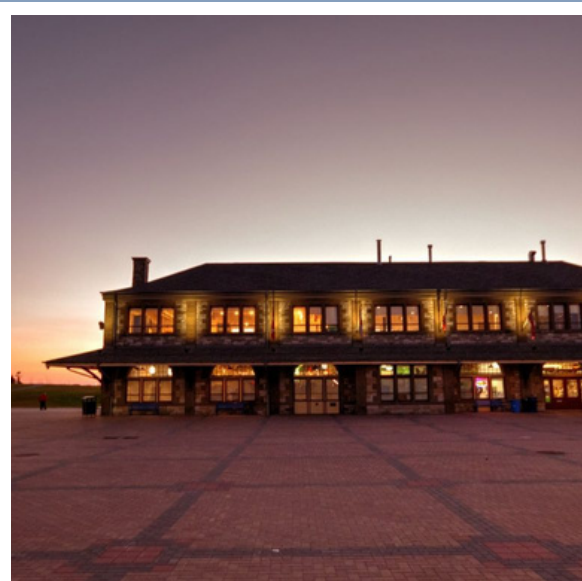


### [Leisure Farms](#)

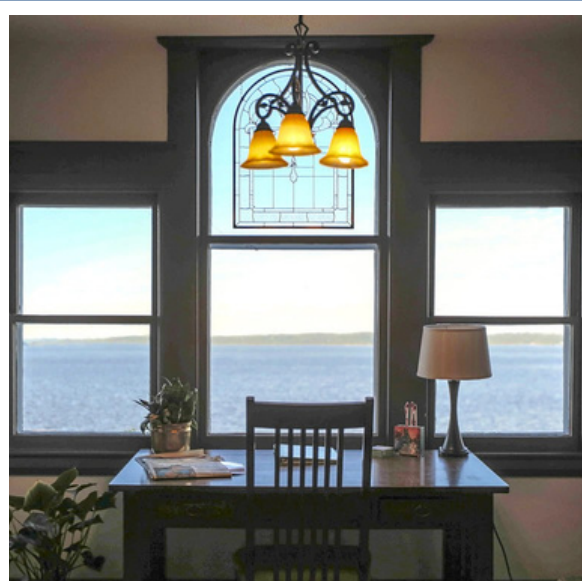


### [Lake Temiskaming Tour](#)
